POLA Opening

On Monday 25th September, Week 10 we will be having the official opening of our Preschool Outdoor Learning Area. Melissa, Sadie and Helen have been working hard to coordinate the event. There will be a number of official guests from DECD as well as community members, Reception parents who were involved in the planning, Council members and the media. Governing Council will also be there to represent the school parents.

We ask that on this day parents do not use the preschool carpark in the afternoon as we need to reserve this for the DECD Chief Executive and others. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Sports Day

After discussion and looking at options of a suitable day and week for Sports Day it has been set for Thursday 26th October. This year it will take place as a normal school day instead of the twilight times from last year. After discussion with staff there were a number of factors that impacted on the arrangements for this year. In previous years the day closure allocated to schools was able to be planned for the following day which supported students and staff after the late finishing time. Unfortunately this was not able to happen this year as our day closure was used in Term 3 in alignment with Partnership training plans. Suggestions were made about the possibility of holding Sports Day on a Friday however we have identified the importance of our preschool being included in whole school events and this would

mean they could not attend. We understand that there are going to be mixed reactions and opinions about whether a twilight time or regular school day is the best option for students, staff and parents so a feedback form will go to all parents directly after Sports Day. This will enable us to get opinions from as many families as possible. I encourage you to share your thoughts through this feedback form so that we can get an accurate picture and guide our direction for the future. Nothing is set in stone and opinions may result in alternating times each year or identify a definite preference.
